

Since 2010 Pay It Forward SA has been providing those we serve with holistic solutions to substance use disorders that empower meaningful, long-term recovery.

Our dorm programs, housed on the campus of Haven for Hope, offer both men and women a graduated community living environment that teaches them tools to reenter society on their own terms. Participants may stay with us for up to one year and are approved by current residents before being accepted. To date our dorms have served over 1200 people.

Outside campus our Bridge Program serves those entering sober living by assisting with initial move-in costs, giving them the best possible start on their recovery journey. We currently partner with over 100 local facilities in four counties and through these partnerships have helped over 3500 individuals with nearly \$1,100,000 in scholarships.

We are proud to say that over the last 14 years we have served nearly 6000 individuals during their recovery journey.

While in College, Kym opened her own gym, Family Fitness, on the Southside of San Antonio. This gym

Kym created her own candle company, Bear Bottom candles. These candles are hand poured and are made of natural soy was and this company remains a success and is located in California.

Some of the causes that she assists: Uvalde Strong, seniors, children, mental health, education, dogs, cancer, Alzheimer's Disease, child abuse, hunger, clothing, Thanksgiving for the city, special needs, medical equipment, many scholarship programs, GED programs, child burials, hearing impaired, aging out foster youth, Down syndrome, grandparents raising grandchildren, and so many more.

Kym believes, "everyone can give in some way. A person can give of their time, talent, or treasure. They can give at their level, but everyone has the ability to give something."
